THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. The appellant to file and serve 5 copies of its outline of submissions, prepared in accordance with Part B of Practice Note 1, not later than 4.00pm fourteen days before the date fixed for the hearing of the appeal.
2. The respondent to file and serve 5 copies of its outline of submissions, prepared in accordance with Part B of Practice Note 1, not later than 4.00pm seven days before the date fixed for the hearing of the appeal.
3. The appellant to file and serve 5 copies of any outline of submissions in reply, prepared in accordance with Part B of Practice Note 1, not later than 4.00pm on the last working day before the date fixed for the hearing of the appeal.
4. Outlines of submissions for the appellant shall not exceed 30 pages in length.
5. Outlines of submissions for the respondent shall not exceed 10 pages in length.
6. Each party must file and serve a list of authorities and legislation in accordance with Practice Note No 19.
7. The proceedings be set down for hearing on a date to be fixed.
